The George Goodwin Award is presented to a Chapter member annually in recognition of significant contributions to the community through volunteer service in civic, cultural, charitable, educational and/or religious work. These contributions, which must not be solely on behalf of an employer or client, may involve service to one or many groups. Nominees must be current members of PRSA Georgia. Nominees may be currently serving in a leadership or volunteer role with the Chapter. However, the focus of the award is volunteer support given to non-profit organizations outside of the Chapter or job duties. It is acceptable to contact the nominee for information.

If the nominee's company provides financial support to any of the organizations in which the nominee is involved, explain how the support is provided, and if the nominee's involvement is voluntary.

Up to three letters of recommendation may be submitted as a supplement to the nomination. These should be included as PDF documents attached below. **Any letter of recommendation should provide additional information not included in the nominee's application form.** Letters of recommendation are not required.
